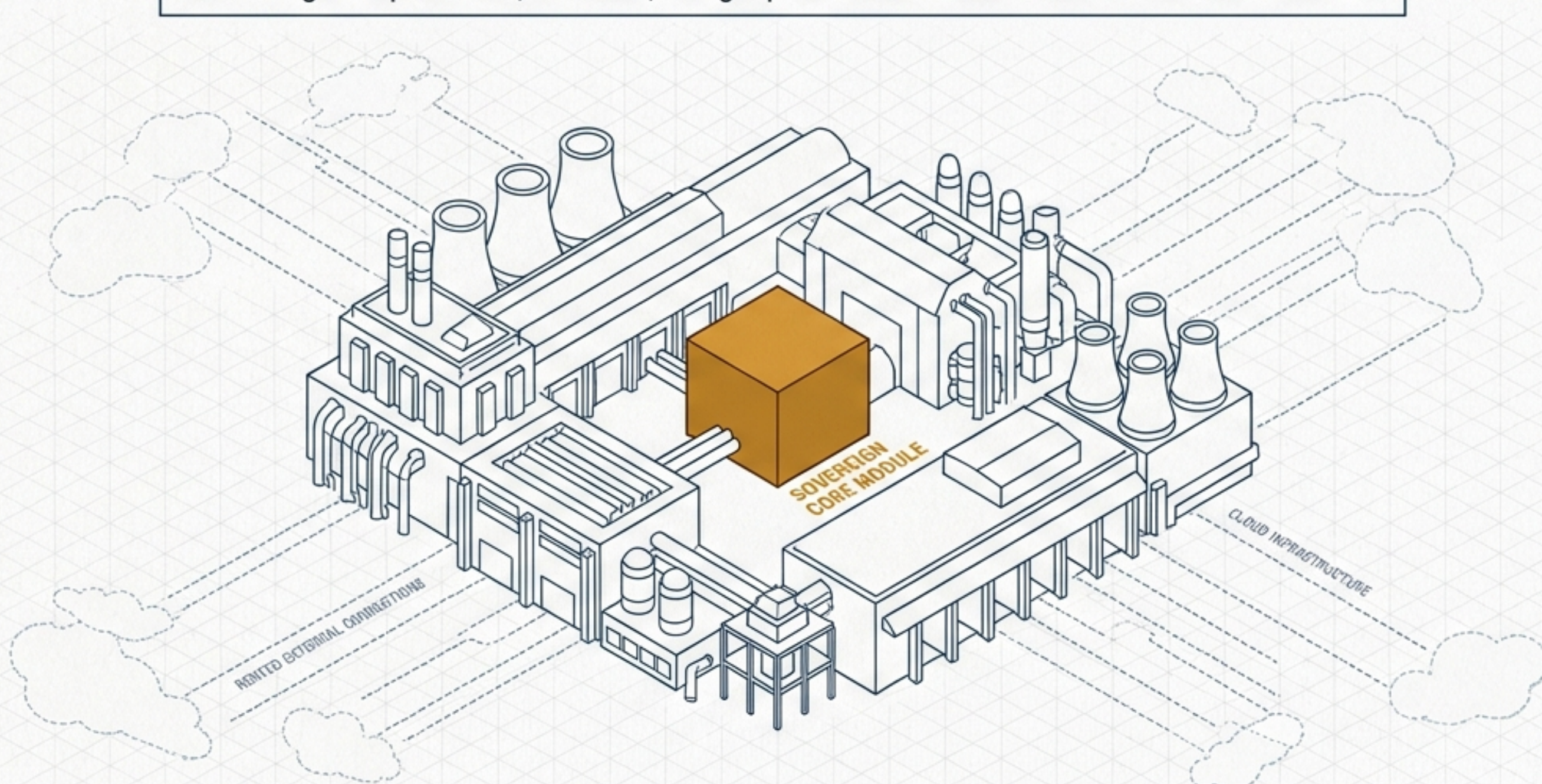


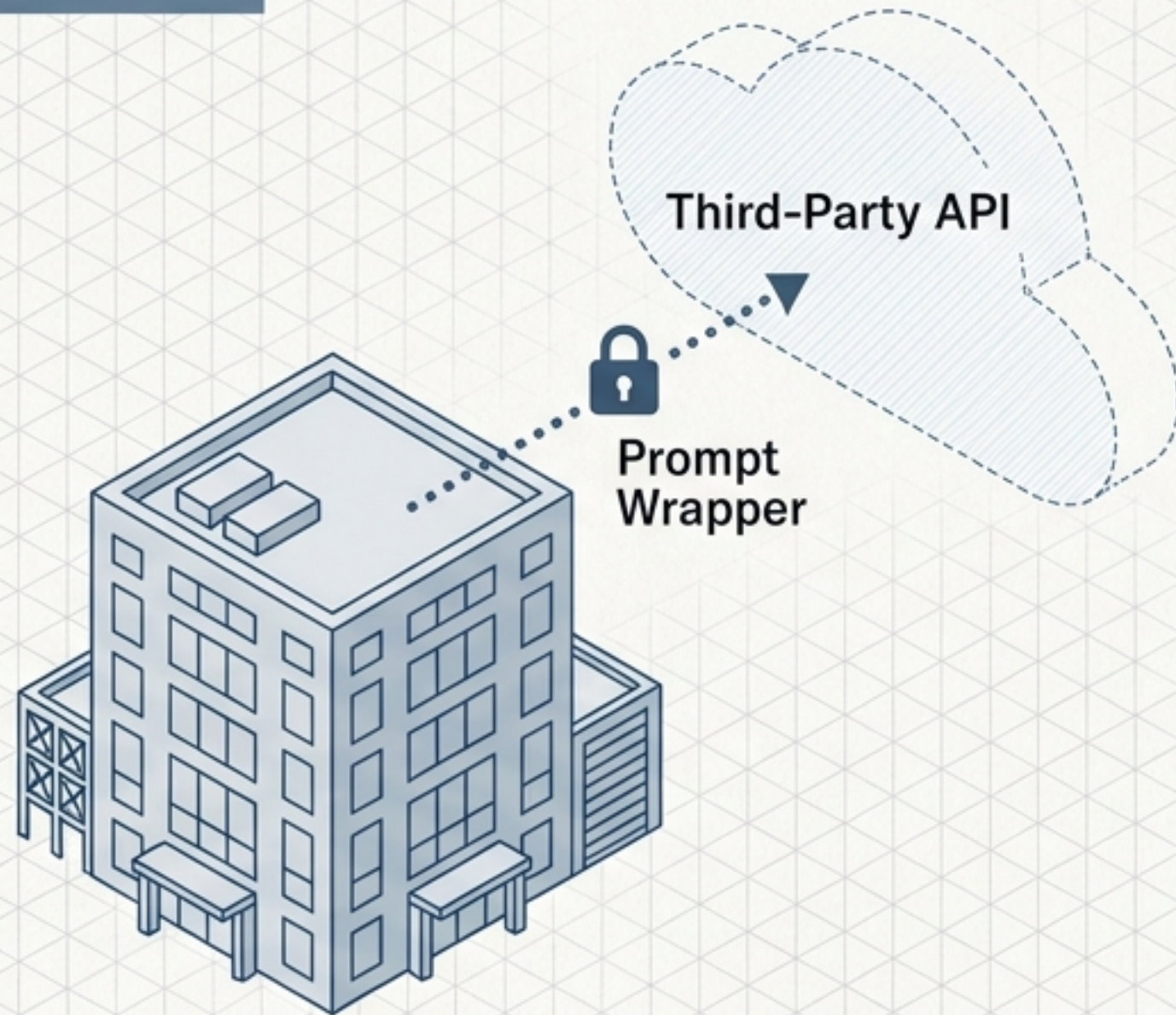

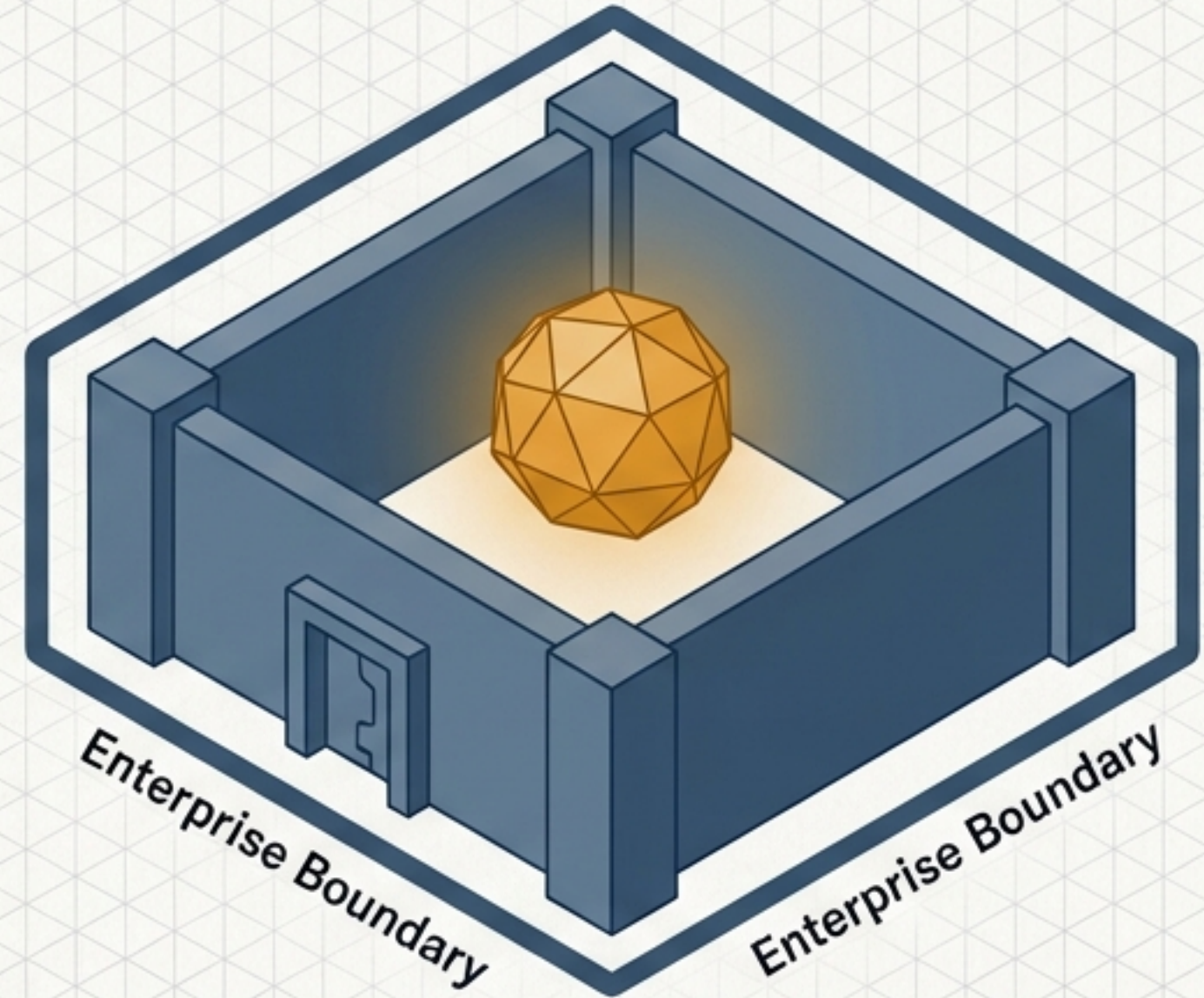
# The Era of Renting APIs is Facing a Structural Alternative

## The API Era



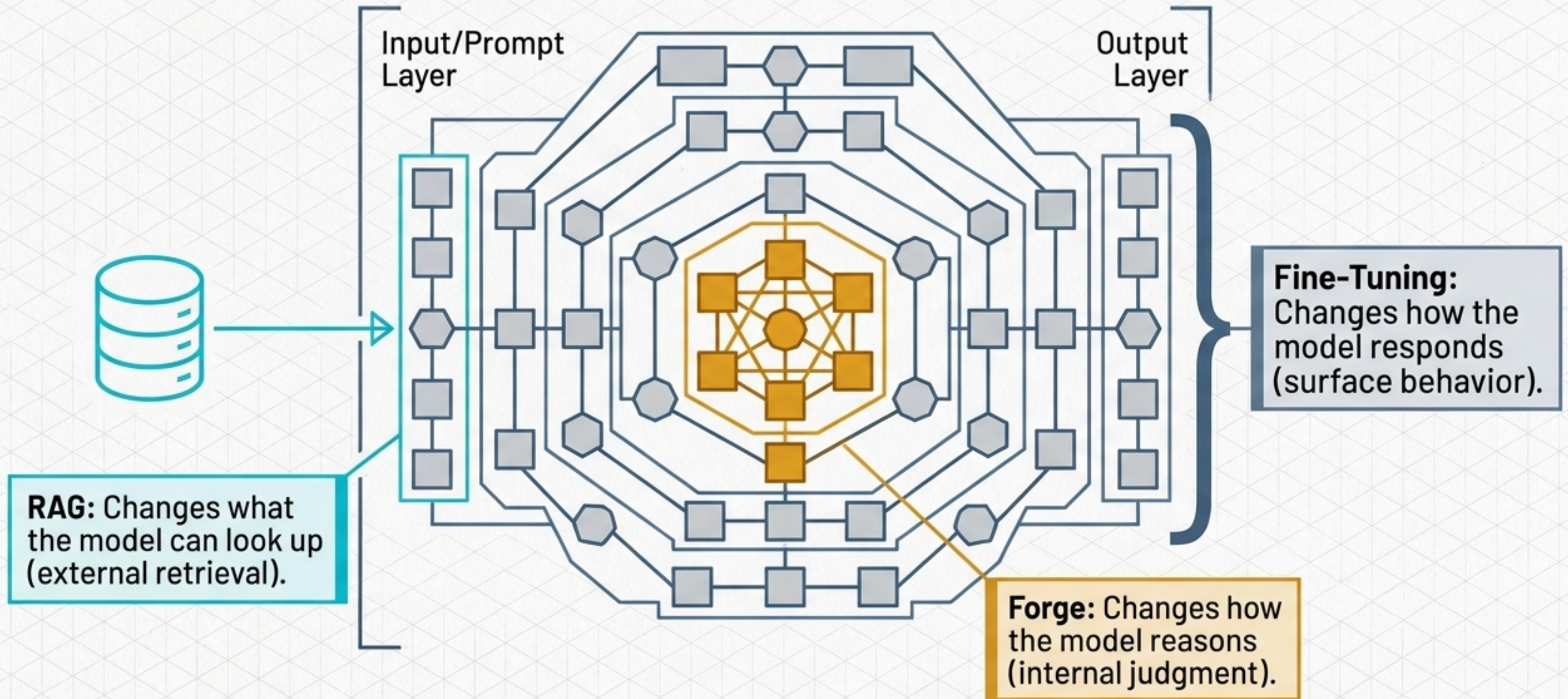
For two years, enterprise AI has meant renting a general-purpose model, bending it with prompts, and wrapping it in retrieval pipelines.

## The Sovereignty Era

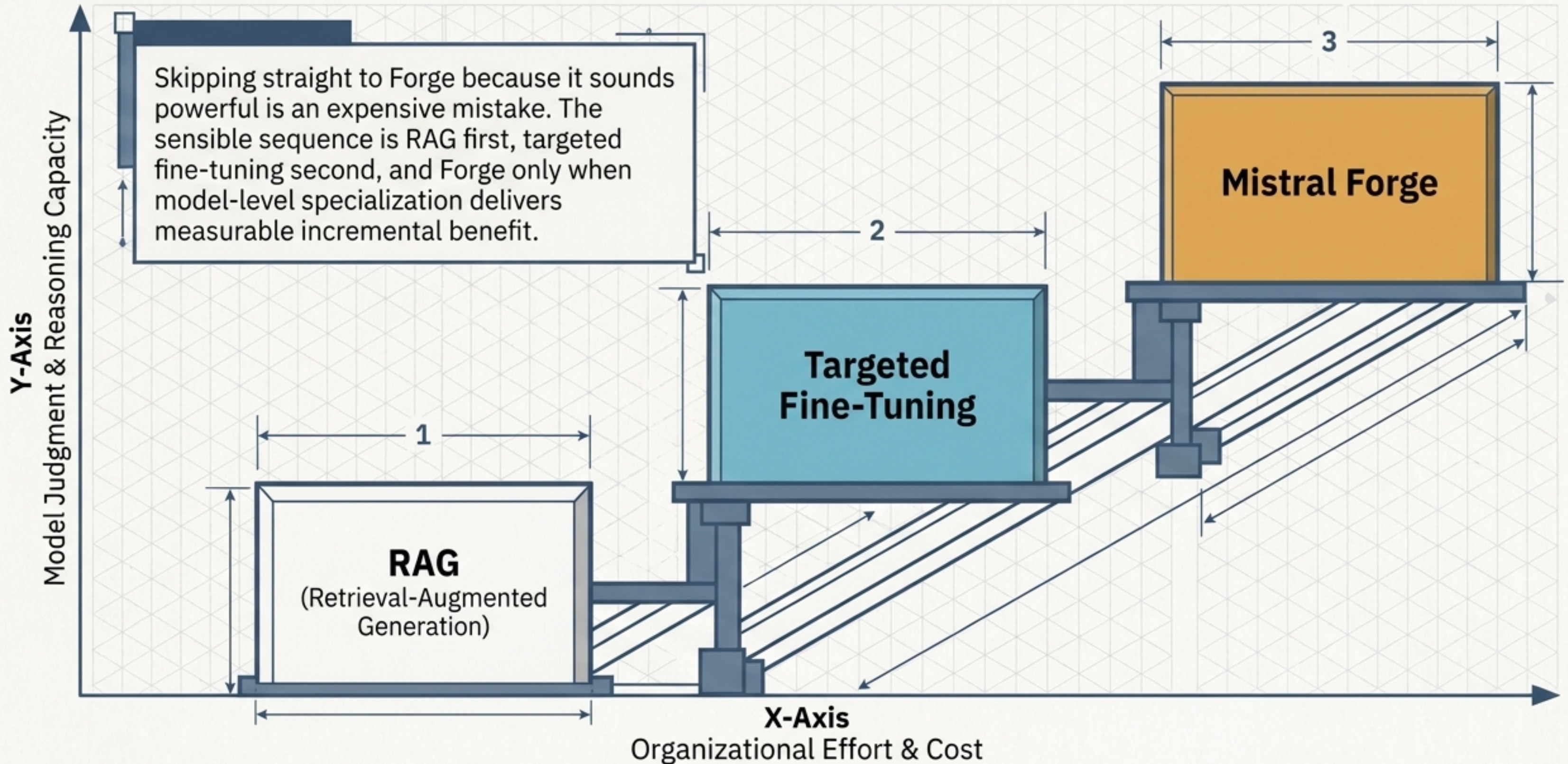


Mistral's thesis with Forge is blunt: Build a model that *is* your company. Train it on your proprietary rules, code, and documents, and run it inside your own walls.

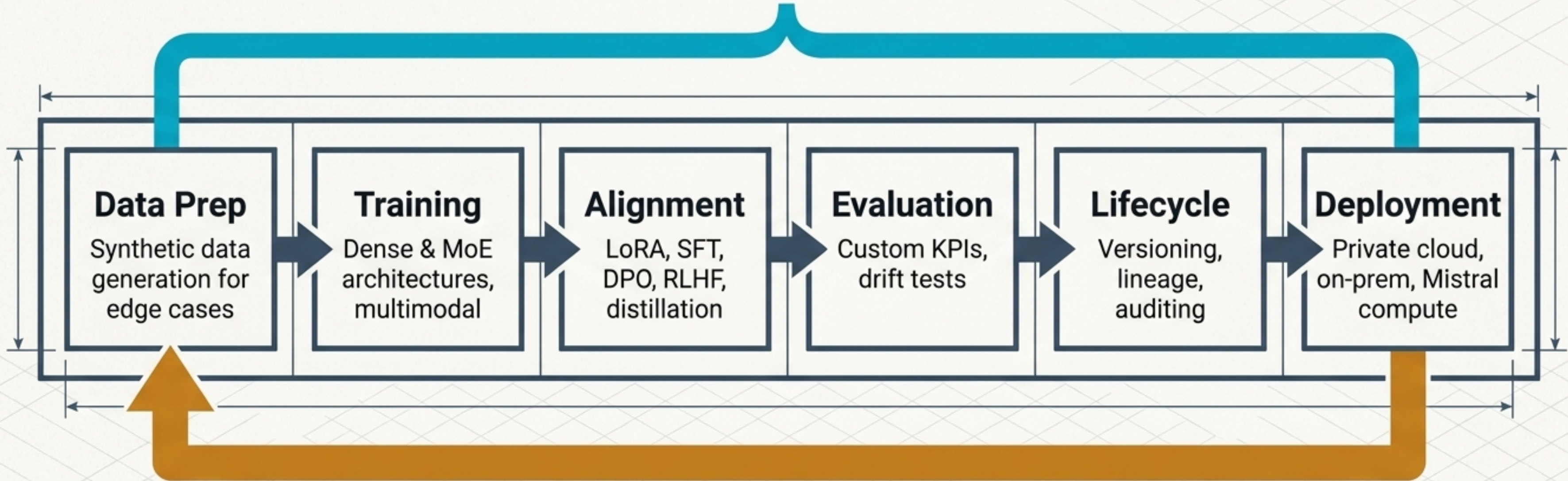

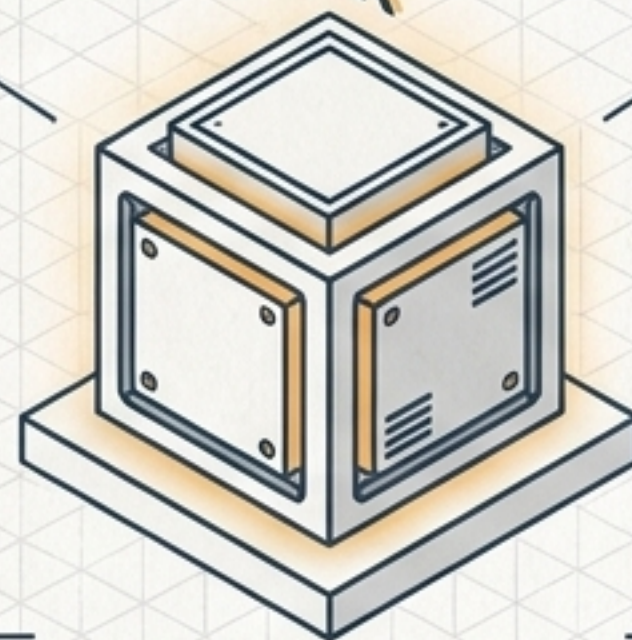

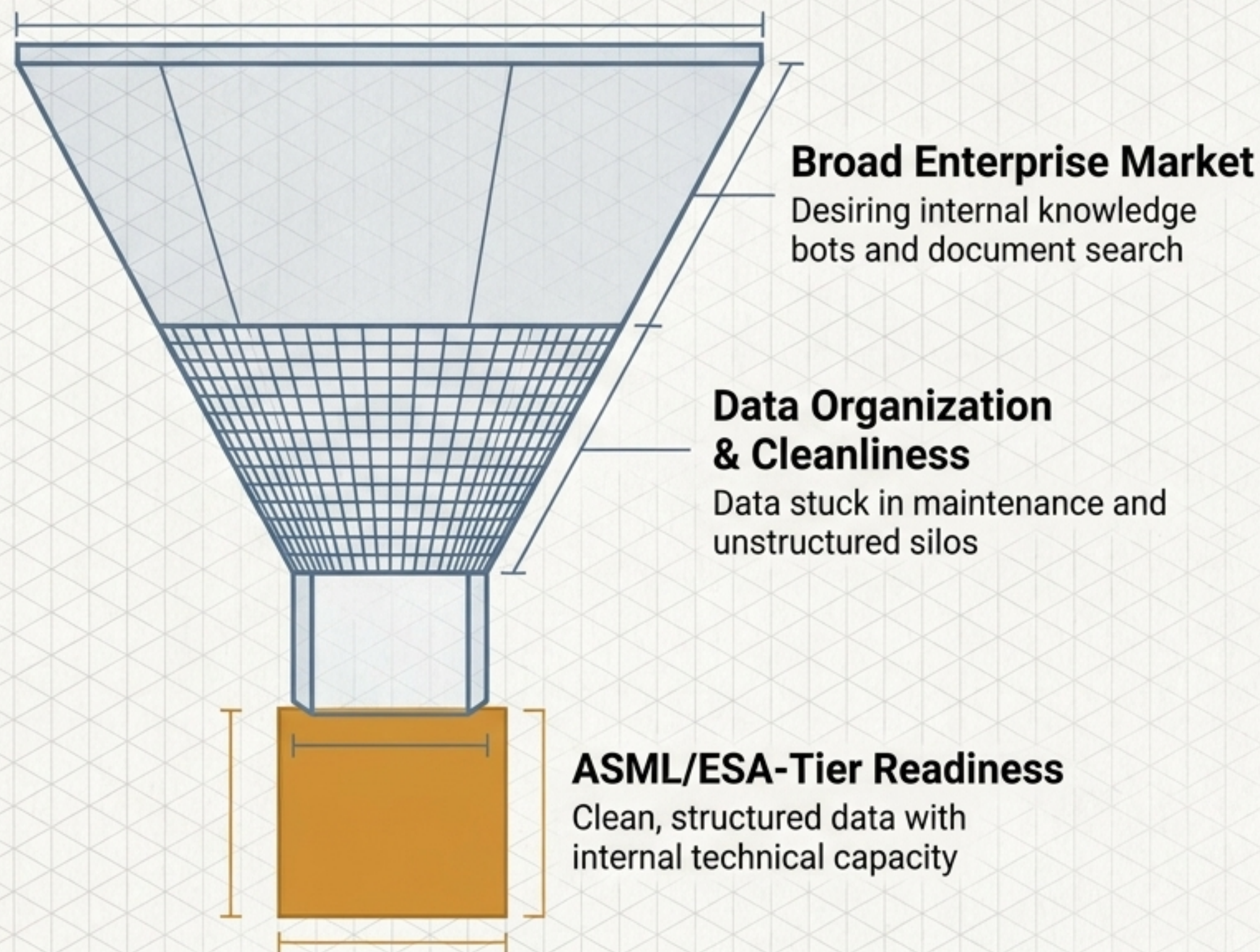

# The Futurum Critique: Measuring Enterprise Data Maturity

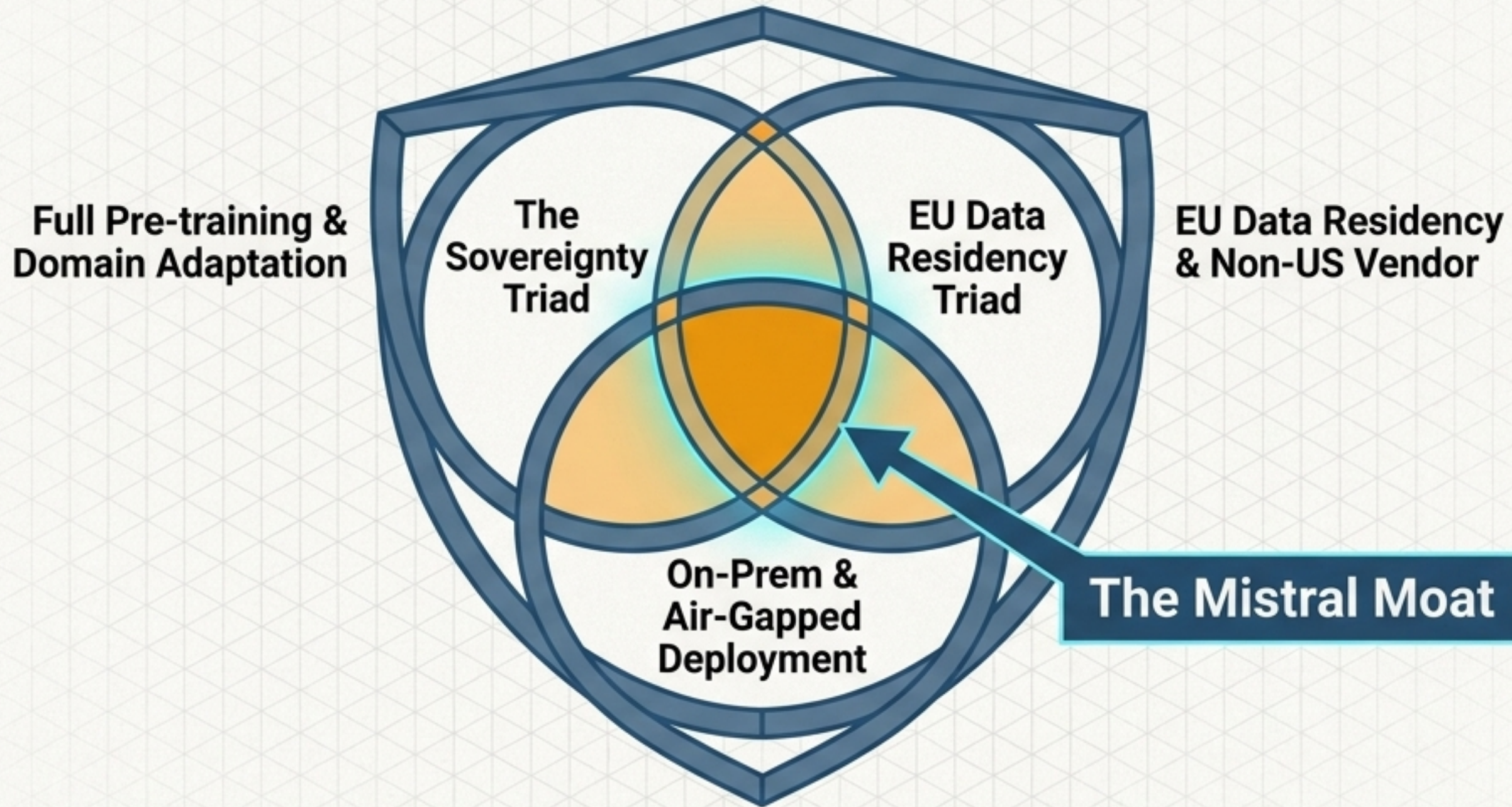


Analysts at Futurum warn that the addressable market is currently narrower than Mistral implies.

Organizations spending more than half their time simply maintaining and organizing data are not ready for a sovereign training program.

For the typical enterprise, Forge is overkill.

# The Sovereignty Moat: Hedging Against API Lock-In



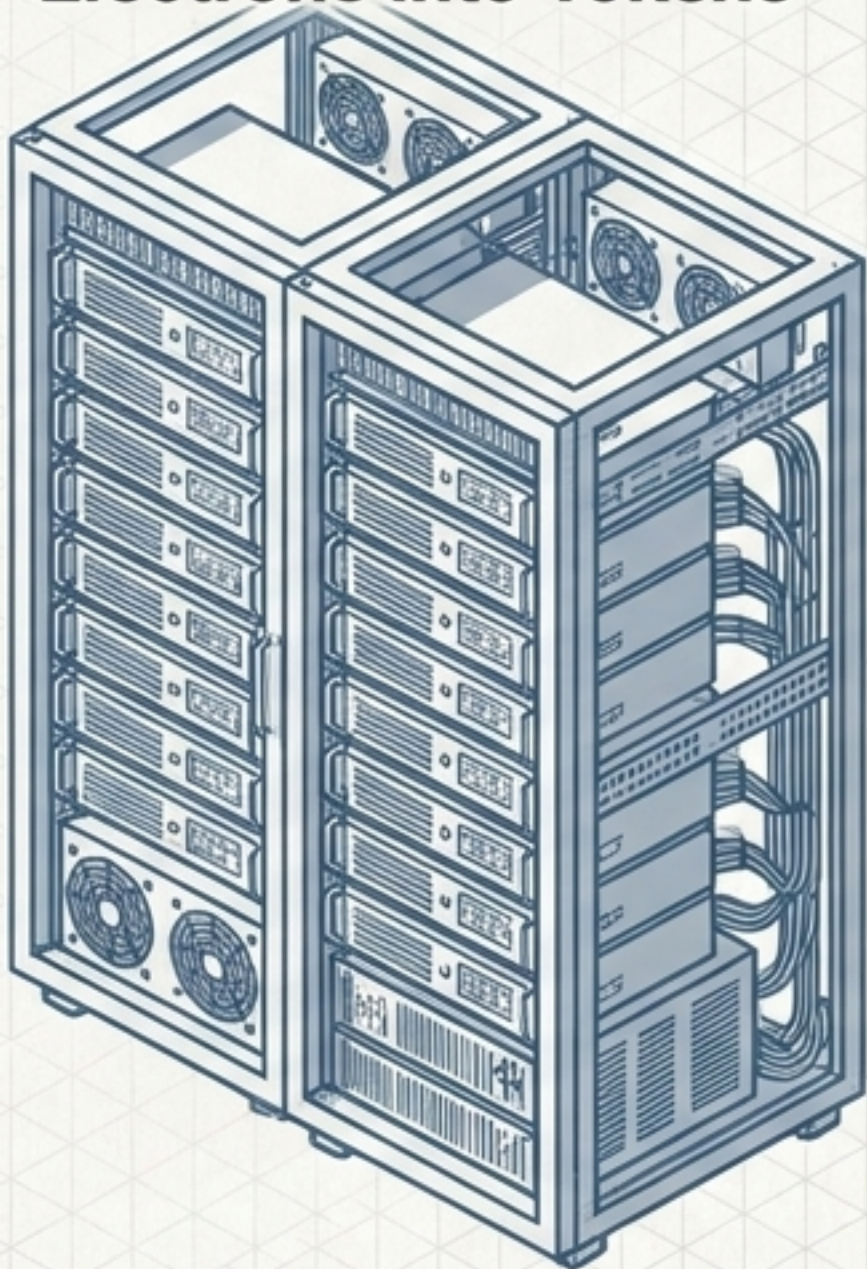
OpenAI and Anthropic offer custom enterprise programs. Mistral's genuine distinction is the *combination* of these three factors in a single managed platform.

In a year when frontier model access proved to be a geopolitical variable (subject to government shutdown directives), sovereignty is no longer a philosophical preference. It is an operational hedge.

# Total Stack Control: The Air-Gapped Standard

The highest expression of Forge is fully **air-gapped deployment**, as utilized by Singapore's **HTX**.

The customer **retains outright control of the models**, the infrastructure, and the knowledge.

Supported globally by **integration partners like TCS** (announced May 2026) to manage the deployment ecosystem without compromising the sovereign boundary.

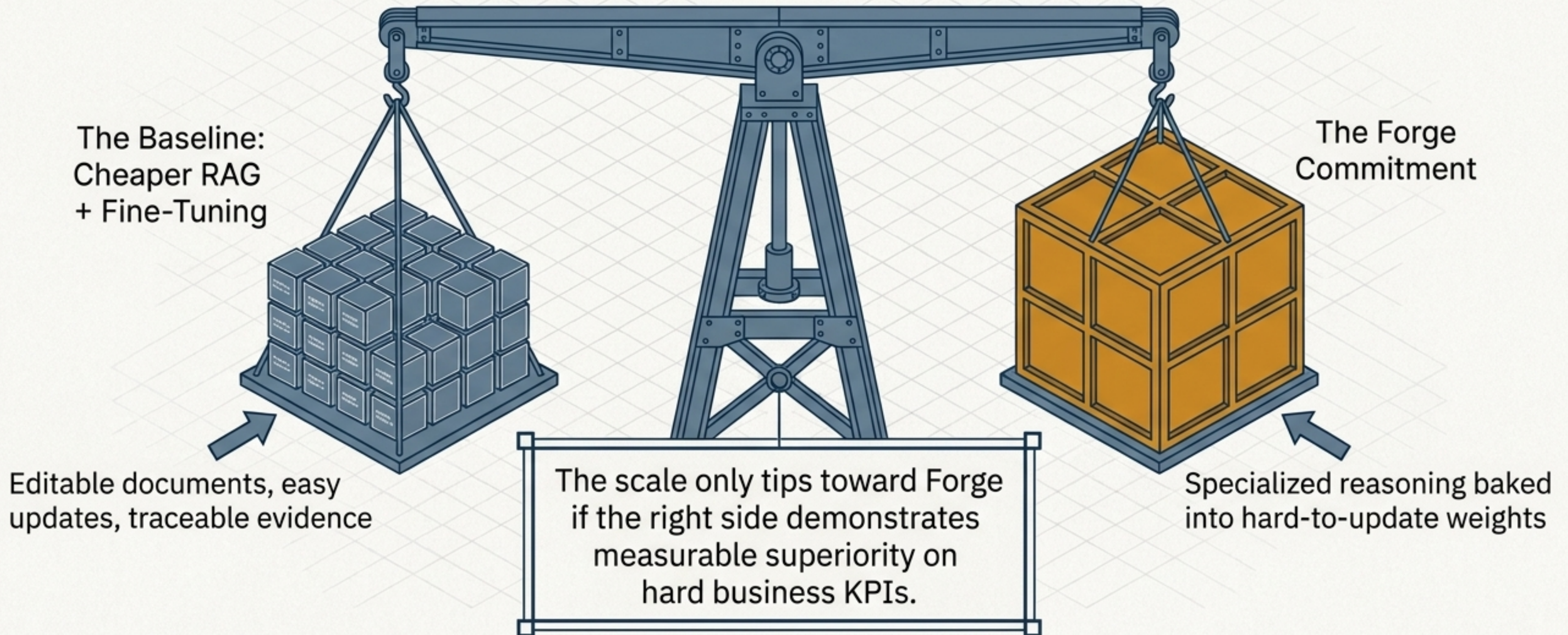

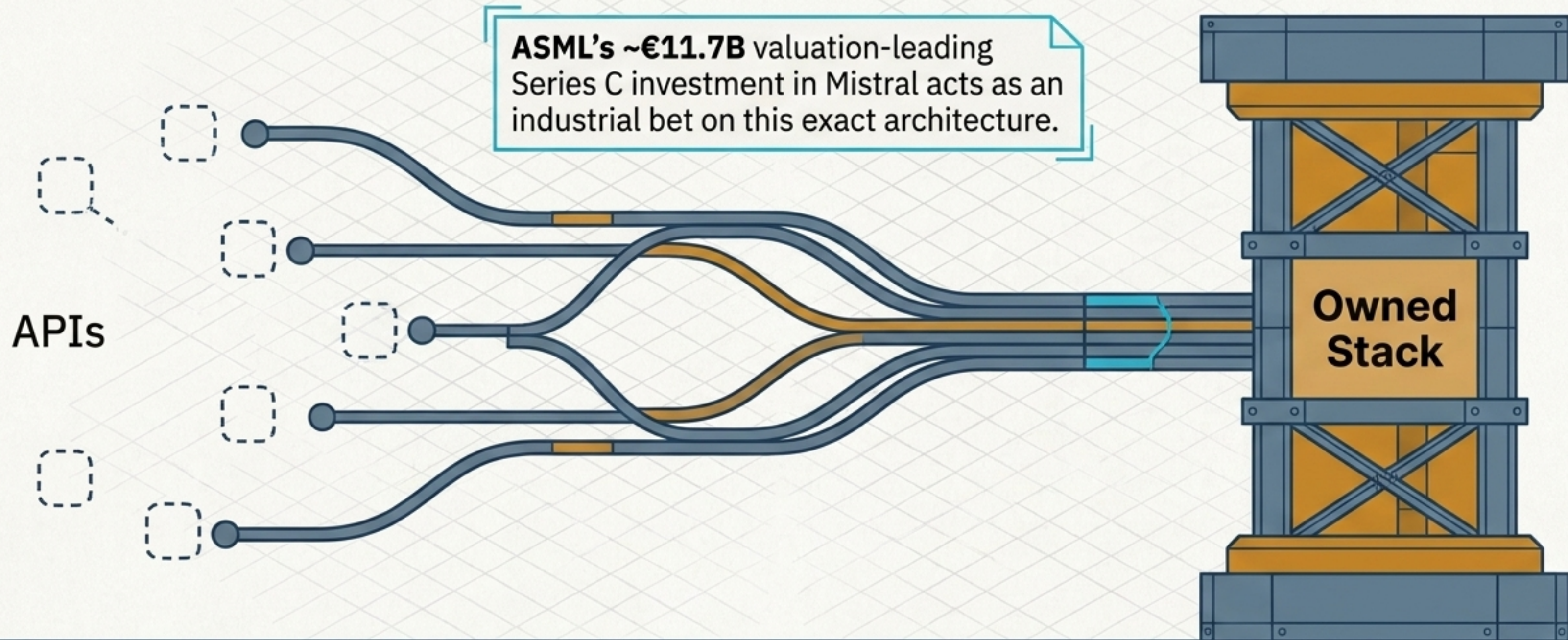
**Operational Ownership:** Who manages red-teaming and incident response?

# The Mandatory Due Diligence: The Controlled Bake-Off



Because the platform is months old and public evidence comes mostly from partners, a serious buyer must insist on a controlled proof-of-concept against competing open-model approaches on actual business tasks.

# The Direction of Travel: Electrons into Tokens



The enterprise AI question has permanently shifted from 'Which API do I call?' to 'Do I own the model?'

A European champion has planted a flag on the far end of that spectrum. You may not need to stand there yet, but the direction of travel unmistakably points toward owning your stack.
